

Rookie Division "Short" Rules (2019) Orangeville & Headwaters Minor Baseball Association

Playing Field

- 1. The home team is responsible for setting up the field 15 minutes prior to first pitch and providing one game ball (taken from the shack or equipment box)
- 2. ROLB1x balls are not to be used in games only practice
- 3. Field dimensions are as follows: 60 ft baselines, 40 ft pitching distance and 85 ft from home plate to second base (note: hammers and tape measures are provided)
- 4. Complete rules and set up for pitching machine are in the full rules
- 5. Each coach is responsible for ensuring the dugout (bench) is clean after each game
- 6. Games are 1 hour and 30 minutes in length from their **originally scheduled start time** with no new inning after the 1 hour and 30 minute mark

Uniform & Equipment

- 1. All players must wear their OHMBA provided uniform including jersey and pants (no shorts)
- 2. Jerseys must be tucked in and baseball hats worn while on the field
- 3. Only rubber cleats are permitted
- 4. Protective cups are encouraged for all players but are mandatory for pitchers and catchers
- 5. Catchers must use catchers mitts and protective gear
- 6. The player in the pitching area must wear a batting helmet

Division Rules

- 1. The infield fly rule does not apply
- 2. Until June 30th batters will be given the option to hit off the tee after their fourth pitch
- 3. Lead offs are not allowed
- 4. Runners may not advance until the batter has made contact with the ball
- 5. Runners may not advance on a passed ball or wild pitch
- 6. Batters may not advance on a dropped third strike
- 7. Extra bases will not be awarded on an overthrow to first base
- 8. Bunting is not allowed
- Teams will score a maximum of 5 runs per inning, however the fourth and subsequent innings are open (allowing teams to score as many runs as possible)
- 10. A 15 run mercy rules takes effect after the completion of 4 1/2 innings
- 11. A half inning will be considered 3 outs or 10 batters
- 12. Home plate sliding rule applies (see full rules for explanation)
- 13. If both teams have at least 10 players then a fourth outfielder may be added

General Rules

- 1. In the first five innings of every game every player must play one inning of outfield and one inning of infield (note catcher and pitcher count as infield)
- 2. A player must not sit on the bench for a second time until every other player has done so
- 3. A team must have seven players to play a game (note see call up rules to avoid this)
- 4. Sole catcher rule: if a team only has one catcher available they are exempt from rule #1
- 5. Late players can play however they must be put at the bottom of the batting order

Coaches

- Cannot question umpire judgement calls and must refrain parents or players from questioning umpire calls
- 2. Relax and have fun
